Ready Set Girls Academy (RSGA)

Through our flagship program, we've created a curriculum to teach young women essential life skills and coping techniques by improving their self-esteem and encouraging them to reach for higher achievement. Offered to middle school and high school girls, our curriculum includes extra lessons for college and career exploration, which can include field trips, guest speakers, and hands-on volunteer projects.

Ready Set Women Academy (RSWA)

We bring together and empower women from all walks of life to promote positive professional growth. Workshop topics include leadership, work-life balance, negotiation, management, and more.

Giving Back Program

This program connects IHSF with a broad array of community projects offered through partnering organizations allowing us to provide hands on opportunities to impact our neighborhoods and those in need throughout Chicagoland.
